- Help your child complete their homework. We will have weekly spelling/times table challenges and a homework task to reinforce learning done that week. Homework is given out every Friday and needs to be returned by the following Friday.
- If you as parents/guardians feel that you can contribute to our learning topics, your input would be very welcome.

#### **Other useful information.**

- **Physical Education** will take place every **Thursday**. Please bring a suitable P.E kit into school this week (a t-shirt, shorts/leggings/jogging bottoms and trainers/pumps). These can be kept in school and will be sent home every half term to wash.
- Please provide **fruit** and **water** every day, (no squash or juice is allowed). School will provide milk.
- Your child will be released every day from the bottom of the ramp which is situated at the front of the school at 3.20pm. If someone different is picking up your child, please telephone the school or inform a member of staff beforehand. We will only release your child to a nominated adult
